Sustainable Rossmoor's Recent Activities

And Accomplishments include:

- **passage of AB 634**, a state law that makes it easier for condo/co-op owners to install solar panels.
- **the GRF solar array**, designed to provide two-thirds of the electrical power for Rossmoor's common buildings.
- **the electric vehicle charging stations** at Gateway, the Event Center, and the Fitness Center.
- **the Trash Talk/Recycling Committee**, helping to reduce waste and make organic waste (composting) available.
- **the Water Conservation and Sustainable Landscaping Committee**, which encourages efficient irrigation, low-water-use landscaping, and care of our scarce fresh water resources.
- **Film Night**, a monthly series in Peacock Hall featuring a variety of short films and documentaries focused on sustainability.
- **Earth Week/Month** celebrations, featuring demonstrations, presentations, and films focused on taking better care of our fragile planet.
- **publication of "Earth Matters"**, a bi-monthly column in the Rossmoor News.
- **Planet-Friendly eating**, promoting plant-rich diets and reduced food waste.
- **Tree Planting and preservation** in Rossmoor and beyond.
- **100% Renewable Energy through MCE.**
